

Nursing homes and nursing beds in residential homes are closing in Devon, Cornwall and Somerset due to the inability to recruit qualified nurses to these settings. The lack of qualified nurses also means mentors are not available to support learners = vicious circle in terms of recruitment

A Collaborative Learning in Practice (CLiP) Community Cluster (CCC) model of education has potential to change this scenario

Already widely adopted in the Acute Setting, HEE in the South West is working with partners in the Nursing Home, Primary Care and Hospice settings to pilot a CCC model using a hub and spoke arrangement

Project: CCC – A primary care and community collaboration

- Consider current CLiP activity and outcomes delivered in settings other than Primary and Community Care
- Pilot CCC Models of working across Devon, Cornwall and Somerset
- Focus on Nursing Homes, GP and hospice settings with learner nurses + ensure multidisciplinary opportunities across a range of settings
- Cross organisation communication process and collaborative system wide working
