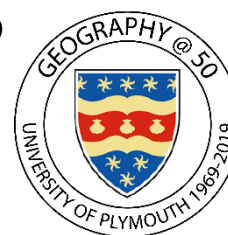


## Geography Research Seminar Schedule Winter/Spring 2019
